TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- 4 Games:
 - All games except Championship Game and 3rd Place game: 2 x 35 minute halves with a 5-minute half time. Tie immediately to high school style shootout.
 - Championship & 3rd Place game: 2 x 40 minutes with a 5-minute half time. Tie immediately to high school style shootout.
- Cautions & Ejections
 - If at any time a player receives 2 cautions during the tournament she will be suspended for the next game.
 - If a player is ejected at any point she will be suspended from the remainder of the tournament.
- Rosters
 - Teams are required to provide rosters for the opponent, officials, and press box prior to each game.
- Home/Visiting Team
 - Home team is designated first on the schedule and sits on the West sidelines.
 - I have no problem who wears dark or light jerseys as long as both teams and referees are satisfied. If there is a discrepancy we will follow OSSAA standards.
- All Tournament Selections
 - You should have already nominated your players
 - Circle 11 players from other teams (not your own players)
 - All-tournament ballots must be returned to me by the end of your third game.
 - The player with the most votes will be selected the MVP.
- Trainer & Water
 - A trainer will be on site for any athletic training assistance and emergencies. There will be water containers provided on the sidelines, but no water bottles, so please bring your own bottles or cups.
- Hospitality
 - There will be lunch and dinner provided both days and breakfast of Saturday for coaches, staff, and officials. There are plenty of goodies for a snack as well.
- Awards:
 - There will be team trophies for Champions, Runner-up, and Third Place.
